Background

This website provides an introduction to the proposal for our new Orthopaedic Centre of Excellence at Guy's Hospital.

The proposed Centre of Excellence is part of Guy's and St Thomas' NHS Foundation Trust's plan to invest in our clinical services. The state-of-the-art treatment facilities will enable us to continue to provide high quality care to our patients and be a hub for training, education and leading-edge research.

Building design

To meet the future health service requirements, the new building will include:

- Eight fully equipped modern theatres
- Individual medi-rooms for consultation, preparation and post-surgery care and recovery
- Support services including a new reception and waiting area
- A dedicated staff area
- A new flexible education and training centre for staff and students.

Our orthopaedic services at Guy's Hospital currently run from four main theatres, one day surgery theatre, two inpatient wards and a dedicated outpatient area.

The demand for orthopaedic services is growing as the population ages. To meet this demand, we are proposing to deliver a state-of-the-art treatment and education facility.

The proposed building has been designed in collaboration with patients, staff, healthcare professionals and other key stakeholders. The proposed design is informed by both the needs of the service and the local environment.
